

'Photofont'..... Year 12 Photography: Summer Assignment

Over the summer holidays you are to respond to the alphabet. Each photo you take needs to represent each letter of the alphabet.

Task 1:

Record the alphabet in photos. The only rule: it can't be photos of writing. You can choose to do a theme like the photographers listed on the supporting PowerPoint or you can have a random theme.

Task 2:

Create a message from your letters. Put the photos into an order that spells out a series of words. How you present this alphabet and message is up to you. E.g. in a sketchbook, tape them together into a concertina, tape them in a grid, three-dimensional presentation, digital presentation etc....

The skills you will be marked on:

- Camera control – e.g. sharpness, composition, focal point.
- Creativity with what you have photographed to look like a letter
- The variety of ways you record the letters of the alphabet
- The presentation of the alphabet and words.

Deadline for the assignment is the first day back after the summer holidays. We would strongly suggest you come to A1 or A2 to hand it in, even if you don't have photography on that day. This assignment will be your first formal assessment of the A level Photography course.
