Communication

What can I expect from Ashby School if my child has Special Educational Needs and Disability?

The school will ensure every student is able to access a full curriculum including trips and extracurricular activities.

Teaching will be personalised where needed to meet your child's needs with extra support when required.

All Teaching staff receive training to ensure they are able to support the specific needs of students.

Appropriate and effective Teaching and Learning

We will work in partnership with you, your child and agencies to ensure your child's needs are being met and they are able to access a full curriculum successfully.

A Partnership Approach

The school will provide details for organisations that can support you and your family.

Support

Pastoral teams: provide support for students requiring support with managing behaviour, attendance and dealing with social situations.

LINC: is designed to support students who require intervention regarding their social, emotional and mental health needs.

Learning Support Team: the staff are a highly trained team to support students with SEND needs to access a full mainstream Education.

Interventions: are small groups or 1:1 specialist focused sessions designed to enhance students' literacy and numeracy skills to accelerate their progress in these areas.
